The CDC Director, Debbie Lanier, has faced a difficult period and needs prayers for her and the CDC. Finding teachers has been a difficult task, the flu bug has not been kind to our children, and this negative news" about the CDC is simply wrong. Despite the challenges, Debbie has done an excellent job in keeping the CDC one of the great ministries of our church.
