Beginning this Sunday, July 5-One Worship Service Only at 11:00AM

The response of regathering for worship has been as expected. Many of you are deciding to continue to worship via radio and Facebook live. Due to the small number who are attending in person, we will be having only one service, at 11:00 AM, for the month of July. For those who normally attend at 8:55AM, please join us at 11:00. The attire will be casual, and the order of worship will be blended. Also, please remember and follow the regathering plan below which was approved by our deacons.

FBC Worship Regathering Information

Honor this plan returning to worship as we believe it is the best way to honor God and love others.

- 1. We will reopen with worship through July only at 10:55 AM. Worship spaces will be set up for social distancing. Please do not rearrange the seating.
- 2. We strongly encourage those at risk persons—those with underlying physical conditions, age concerns, and those who do not feel well—to wait to return to church. We will encourage all to wear masks and be considerate of social distancing guidelines.
- 3. The fellowship hall, staff, and sanctuary doors will be opened and monitored. Please observe social distancing as you enter and exit.
- 4. Vocal music will be done with solos and duets. Instrumental music will continue. At this time there will be no congregational singing.
- 5. The children's sermon will be in both services but the children will not come forward. Children will need to stay with their family for the entire worship service.
- 6. We will encourage everyone to greet each other from an appropriate social distance and encourage lengthy discourse to occur outside the church building.
- 7. We will use the monitors in the fellowship hall and only a bulletin in the sanctuary (no hymn books). These bulletins will be prepared in-house and with extra care. Each worshiper will pick up their own bulletin inside the doors to the sanctuary as they enter.
- 8. The offering plates will be spread out in the worship space and not passed person to person. Social distancing is encouraged, and you may give your offering before or after worship.

Glenn's Pen

The hymn was written in recognition of the 500th anniversary of the Reformation. It was given to a church and given to glorify God. The first line reads:

I am pleased to announce that this hymn, written by our own Dr. Carl Ashley, for our first hymn festival at First Baptist, will be the featured hymn on Friday July 3, at the Annual Conference of the Hymn Society in the US and Canada. Carl's faith and talent is a blessing to us and to many others! This hymn is #105 in our Hymnal Supplement and the dedication above it's title reads:

To the Glory of God and for the First Baptist Church of Goldsboro, North Carolina on the occasion of the 500th Anniversary of the Reformation. October 29, 2017

I hope you will join me in giving thanks to Carl for his ministry to us through music. In these challegeing days, we find hope in the final stanza which affirms:

Thy mercy will not fail us, nor leave thy works undone; With thy right hand to help us, the vict'ry shall be won; And then, by men and angels, thy name shall be adored, And this shall be their anthem: one Church, one faith One Lord.

May these words of faith form one of us to he world grant us the strength and hope for today. Amen, Carl.
