AD HOC COMMITTEE FOR FUND RAISING FOR STAINED GLASS WINDOW RESTORATION

The church in conference on April 26, 2017, approved the appointment by the Deacons of Farris Duncan, Ron Barrow, Judy Johnson, Rufus Croom, Gordon Combs, John Casey, Michael McDonald and Sara Sasser to an ad hoc committee to “*plan ways to raise funds to pay for the Stained Glass Window Restoration Project*”. The committee, with Dr. Phillips attending, has met on two occasions but, due to conflicting schedules and other reasons, has not yet had a quorum present. Nevertheless, the members attending discussed and are investigating various ways of fundraising to fund the project in phases.

The report from A&H Art & Stained Glass Co., Inc. has divided the various windows into four phases for cost estimates. Phase I is the North Narthex with its four windows at a cost of \$28,192. The committee has discussed establishing a target date for Phase I of October 1, 2017, to raise \$30,000. The generous support of our church members already, without an organized effort, has resulted in over \$8000 in a designated window restoration fund.

Among methods being discussed is asking members to symbolically purchase a piece of window glass for \$10. The four windows in the North Narthex contain 2600—yes, 2600—individual pieces of glass (according to A&H's estimate). One could purchase as many pieces as he or she chooses and as often as he or she chooses. This could result in a sum of \$26,000. This method could also be applied to the south Narthex.

The committee is also looking into sales of the book about the windows by Lib Gillikin and Randa Haskins as well as selling notecards containing photos of the different windows. This will be determined by the church having the right to reproduce and sell under copyright law and finding a printer that can reproduce at a cost to make it profitable.

We will continue to investigate availability of restoration grants from nongovernmental sources.

Beginning in January 2018, we expect to have a Windows Fund line added to the offering envelopes. Until then we encourage all members to continue making contributions for memorials and other occasions as you have been doing.

We will promote the effort through newsletter articles, emails to the membership, weekly report of the amount in the designated fund and other communications.

Reunion group meetings are an important part of continuing your Emmaus experience. A newly formed group will begin meeting the 1st and 3rd Sundays of each month at FBC.

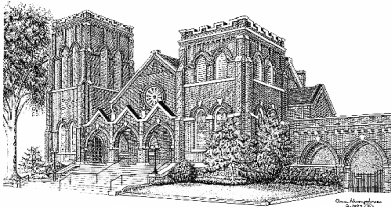
